

2026 PNKCA Koi of the Year



Requirements

1. Koi must belong to a PNKCA affiliated club hobbyist (or past dealer who has been out of business for at least one year and is now a PNKCA club member hobbyist). Koi must be “alive at time of entry” and reside in the hobbyist pond, within the Pacific Northwest.
2. The winner will be selected by attendees at the 2026 PNKCA Convention.
3. Photo submitted (to represent your club) must be of the actual koi being entered, and have been taken within the last year. **No Photo Enhancement of the fish is allowed**, although modification of the background is acceptable.
4. There will be 3 winners, consisting of 1 regular scaled GoSanke Koi, 1 Non GoSanke Koi, and 1 Long Fin Koi.
5. Clubs can only enter one koi per category" (e.g. 1 GoSanke, 1 Non GoSanke and Long Fin).
 - a. Gosankes are fully scaled Kohaku, Sanke, or Showa.
 - b. Non Gonsanke are all other varieties including Doitsu and Gin Rin.
 - c. Longfin Koi – Any variety allowed.
6. Koi that have previously won Koi of the Year are not eligible.

Photo Guidelines

- One koi per photo.
- The image must be sized to fill an 8 x 10 frame.
- The photo must have a blue background, with no advertisement or promotion.
- The koi must have its head between the 5 and 7 o'clock positions (bottom of image) and be as straight as possible.
- Photos shall be submitted to the PNKCA Representative Below.
- Photos will be printed and framed by the PNKCA.
